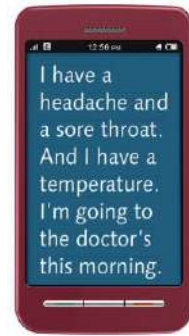


**1 a) Is Ellie ill? Read and find out.**

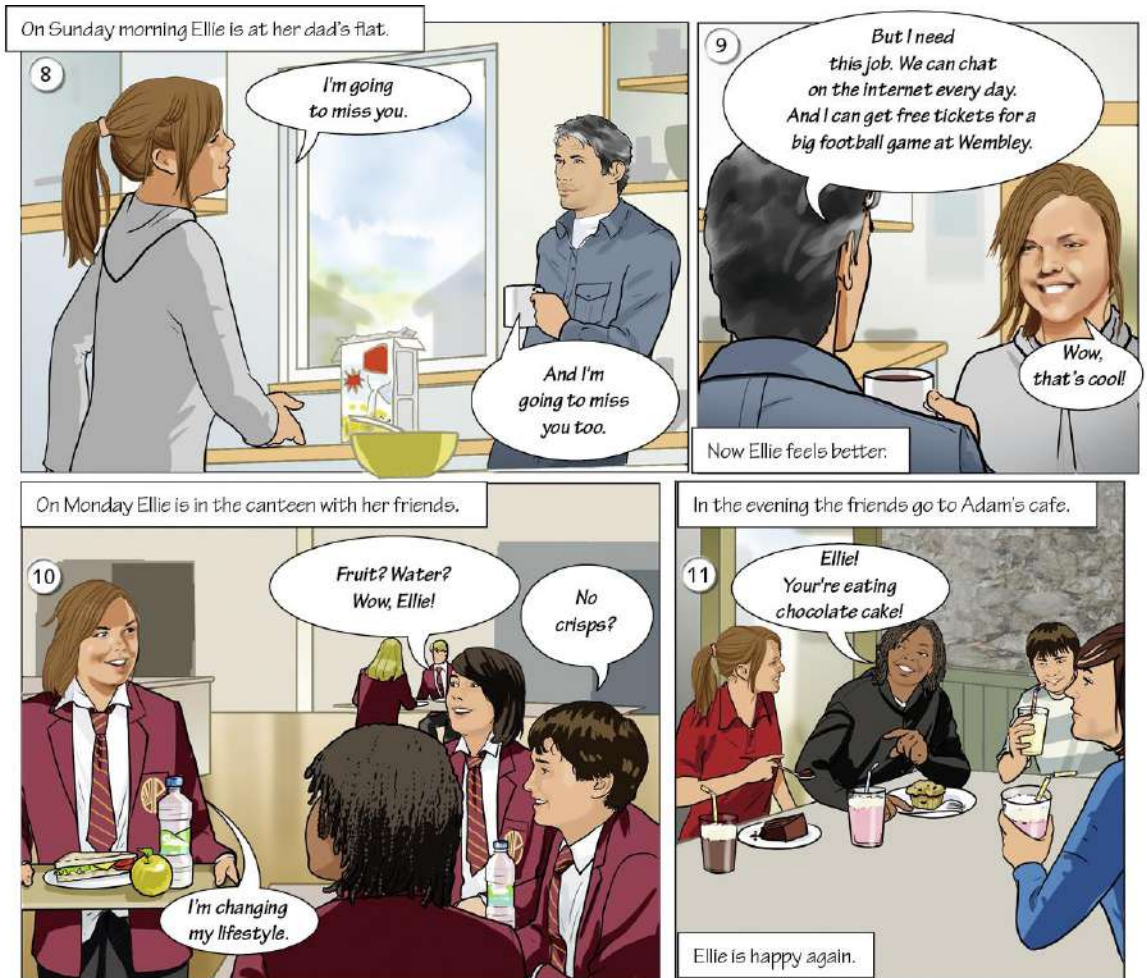

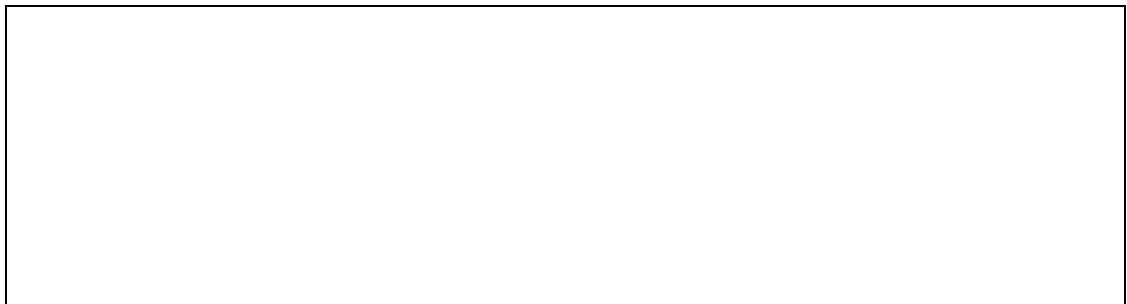
