Man ____ OK. *That's* ____ £59.99 please.

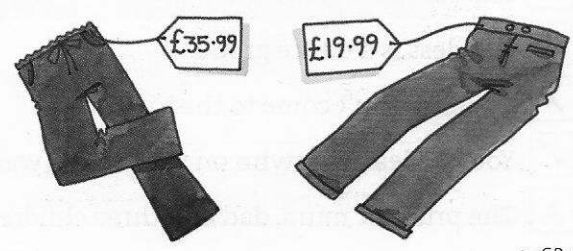
